Introduction

The Control4[®] Bus Power Supply, 48V is intended for use in a Control4 system and installs in a Control4 Panelized Lighting panel. The Bus Power Supply provides the power to the Bus Ethernet Gateway and Control4 Configurable Wired Keypads.

Pre-Installation Instructions

Before You Install in a Control4 Panel

- 1 Use Composer Pro to add the Bus Power Supply to a project, define its location in a panel, and print the panel report. See the *Composer Pro User Guide* for details.
- 2 Install the panel following the instructions in the 5-Slot and 2-Slot Panel Installation Guide.
- 3 Install and wire the Terminal Block for the Bus Power Supply following the instructions in the *Terminal Block Installation Guide* and in the location defined by the Composer Pro panel reports.

Installation Instructions

Install in a Control4 Panel

1 The Mounting Bracket fits both 2-Slot and 5-Slot Panels. If you are mounting into a 2-Slot Panel, gently bend the tab 90 degrees to the left or right (see Figure 1).



IMPORTANT! To prevent sharp edges and cut fingers, use caution when bending the tab and avoid breaking it.

2 Orient the Bus Power Supply bracket with the mounting holes facing down (see Figure 2).

- B Terminal Screws
- C Mounting Holes
- D Bendable Tab
- 3 Insert the Bus Power Supply into the bracket with the screw terminals facing toward you on the left-hand side (see Figure 2).
- 4 Rotate the bracket and Bus Power Supply 180 degrees, align the power supply mounting holes, and attach the Bus Power Supply to the bracket using the screws provided (see Figure 3).

5 Use a screwdriver to remove the screws and the Class 1/2 Swivel Divider plate at the bottom of the panel (see Figure 4). You'll be installing the Bus Power Supply and bracket there.

6 Mount the Bus Power Supply and bracket using the same screws that were used to mount the divider plate (see Figure 5).

Installing the Ferrite Clamp

- 1 Pick up the ferrite clamp and open it (you may need to use a small screwdriver to open it).
- 2 Place the power cable in the clamp, and then thread the cable through the clamp, around the clamp, and back through the clamp again (see Figure 6).
- 3 Close the clamp until it snaps shut.

Troubleshooting

Symptom	Possible Solution
Power supply does not power on.	Make sure the module is connected securely to the Mains power supply.
